

And he devises a creative, not scary way for Rabbit to practice ahead of time so that he ll be prepared. But will practicing be enough to help Rabbit get over his fear? As with many of the books in this series based on the 3D-animated television show Franklin and Friends, this book provides a model for dealing with a real problem --- the fear of public speaking --- faced by small children. This book offers just the right starting point for classroom discussions about all kinds of fears, or for a character education lesson on empathy or caring. It s also a perfect introduction to a similar science project in which children can head outdoors and discover their own wonder of nature to share.
