The law provides that the Commission shall have general supervisory control over the organization of irrigation districts in the state of Montana and do all things necessary for the full development of the irrigable lands. Organization. The act as originally passed carried an appropriation of \$10,000, but through a clerical error the appropriation was reduced to \$2,500. This has been a serious handicap in carrying out the provisions of the bill. A deficiency claim of \$7,500 was authorized pending the action of the coming legislature and all claims for salaries and expenses have been met by deficiency claims since the depletion of the available \$2,500. The past year has seen a great deal of activity in irrigation questions.
